


Chemicals in E-cigarettes

- Acetaldehyde
- Acetone
- Acrolein
- Cadmium
- Chromium
- Diacetyl
- Lead
- Nickel
- Methylbenzaldehyde
- Phenol
- Propanal
- Propylene Glycol
- Tin
- Toulene

High doses of **Diacetyl** have been shown to cause a severe and irreversible obstructive lung disease (e.g. popcorn lung)





DANGER: ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES

Types of Smoke:

- **Side Stream** - smoke that comes from the lighted end of a burning tobacco product
- **Main Stream** - smoke that is exhaled by smokers (e.g. secondhand aerosol)

Side Stream



- **Benzene** - found in gasoline and pesticides
- **Diethylene Glycol** - used in antifreeze and can cause eye irritation and respiratory irritation
- **Isoprene** - Major component in synthetic rubber, can cause cancer

Main Stream

- **Acetaldehyde** - Poisonous solvent and paint stripper, can irritate eyes and skin; cancer causing
- **Cadmium** - Used in car batteries, can increase lung cancer and cause kidney disease
- **Nickel** - Can cause dermatitis, respiratory effects, and cancer
- **Propylene Glycol** - Main ingredient in e-liquids, used in cosmetics, plastics, can increase risk for children's risk of developing asthma

E-Cigarettes contain nicotine, a highly addictive chemical that can harm youth brain development through age 25
